## PRODUCT APPLICATION

### When Applying in Growing Media (best in nursery)

1. Mix Rootella® G with horticulture growing media, approximately 10 kg/m<sup>3</sup> (10 oz/ft<sup>3</sup>). Contact Groundwork BioAg for precise application rate for your media and seedling size. Start with small amount, add more and blend until uniform.
2. Avoid adding fertilizers or compost to the growing media.
3. Fill seedling trays and continue according to standard growing protocol.

### When Coating Root or Root Ball (best upon transplantation)

1. Lightly coat root ball (or bare root) with Rootella® G granules on all sides to maximize root contact.
2. Transplant seedlings and continue according to standard growing protocol.
